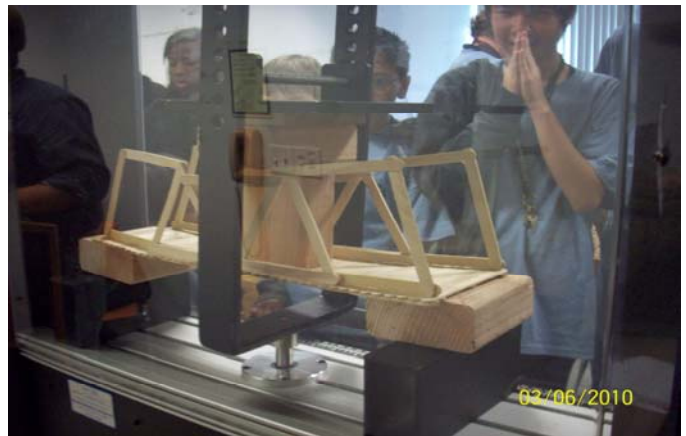
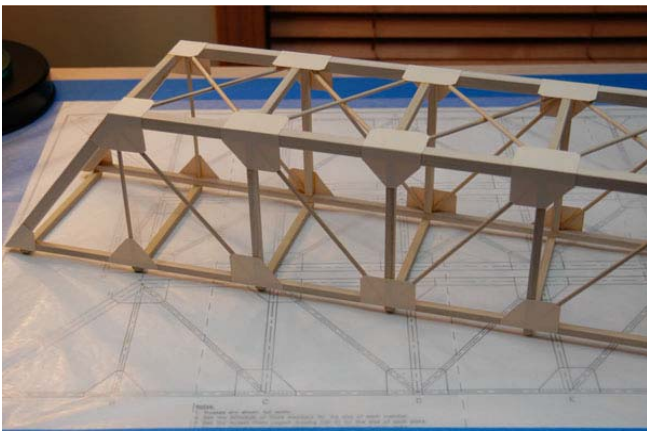


# VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!
