



2012 ASCE SAN DIEGO YMF STUDENT ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The San Diego Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Younger Member Forum (ASCE YMF) is collecting applications for the purpose of awarding three scholarships to students interested in pursuing a degree in civil engineering or a related field at a four-year university. The three scholarships (\$2,500 total) will be awarded as such:

- 2 ~ \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD) or San Diego State University (SDSU) undergraduate or graduate student, or a San Diego region community college student transferring to a four-year university.
- 1 ~ \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD) or San Diego State University (SDSU) undergraduate or graduate student, or a San Diego region community college student transferring to a four-year university.

ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduate or Graduate students:

Must be enrolled in a civil engineering program or related field during the current 2011-2012 academic year at UCSD or SDSU. Open to individuals with academic standing of freshman through graduate student. International students are also eligible. Students completing their education in Spring or Summer of 2012 are not eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2012-2013 academic year.

Community College transfer students:

Must be transferring to a four-year university, located in San Diego County, and enrolling in a civil engineering program or related field for the 2012-2013 academic year. International students are also eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2012-2013 academic year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- One-page Application Form (attached)
- Resume to include the following (minimum):
 - Work Experience (company name, dates/hours worked, job duties, major contributions)
 - o Professional Organization Affiliations (describe involvement and chair positions, if applicable)
 - o Community Service/Involvement
 - o Awards/Honors Received



- Copy of Unofficial Transcript
- One-page typed Essay (choose one of the following prompts):
 - o Briefly discuss a controversial engineering project that affects the San Diego and/or Southern California region. Are you in support of this project? Why or why not? Some examples might include the high-speed rail project, a new Chargers football stadium, recycling San Diego's wastewater into potable drinking water, etc.
 - o Why do you deserve this scholarship? What are your plans and goals for your education and career in Civil Engineering or a related field?
- Note: For community college transfer students, or undergraduate students graduating in Spring/Summer 2012 and continuing on to graduate school, proof of acceptance into the future engineering program will need to be provided prior to the scholarship being awarded. However, proof need not be supplied at time of application submission if you are still waiting for it.

- 1. Review the "Eligibility" section above, then prepare the following items for submission as outlined in the "Application Requirements" section:
 - a. Application Form (signed)
 - b. Resume
 - c. Unofficial Transcript
 - d. Typewritten Essay
