### **Program Structure**

Each freshman or transfer student will be paired with a senior or graduate student. Depending on the number of participating mentees, mentors may be paired with more than one student.

There will be three general meetings each semester with alumni and industry guest speakers that all participants are expected to attend. In addition, each mentee is expected to meet with their mentor at least once a month. They are encouraged to meet more often if needed, however.
