### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- U.S. citizen or national
- Planning a career in teaching and research at the college or university level

### STIPENDS AND ALLOWANCES:

- Predoctoral – \$20,000 to the fellow per year for three years; institution allowance of \$2,000 each year for three years
- Dissertation – \$21,000 for one year
- Postdoctoral – \$40,000 for one year;  
\$1,500 employing institution allowance,  
to be matched by employing institution
