2013 RESEARCH EXPERIENCES FOR UNDERGRADUATES

The Department of Astronomy of Cornell University is pleased to announce its summer undergraduate research program. Students will work on individual research projects with Cornell faculty and research staff on a wide range of topics in planetary science, astronomical instrumentation, astrophysics, general relativity and cosmology. Students interested in computer science and engineering are also encouraged to apply.

The Research Assistantships, which include a stipend of \$6,400 and relocation funds up to \$1,000, are for a flexible ten-week period in the summer. First-, second-, or third-year undergraduates who are US citizens or permanent residents may apply. Students must have completed at least one year of undergraduate academic training by June 2013. Eight Research Assistantships will be available.

Completed applications AND supporting materials must be received by February 4, 2013.
