Program focus is to provide information and incentive to high school students on pursuing health careers.

Qualifications

- Completed at least two years of college work at an academic, accredited institution
- Experience with participant population (high school, low income, first-generation, diverse)
- Experience working with students in a residential setting is highly desirable (for RA's)
- Strong academic background in content areas (IA's- Economics, Govt., Health, Computers, Microbiology, ENS)
- Valid CA Driver's License is preferred
