SDG&E Supports MESA's Innovate Academy

The San Diego State University Mathematics Engineering Science Achievement (MESA) program was the recipient of a \$10,000 San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) Inspiring Future Leaders grant on June 8, 2016.

The grant will support MESA's new Innovate Academy, a mobile 3D printer experience. MESA Innovate Academy will be a train-the-trainer academy for understanding what 3D printing is and how it relates to Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields and careers. MESA Innovate Academy will use a 'Learn, Do, Teach' approach, allowing MESA undergraduates, who will be trained on 3D printing, to expose this technology to various middle and high schools sites throughout San Diego County.

"Students from underserved communities have limited access to new technologies. With SDG&E's support, MESA can provide access to 3D printing technology throughout the MESA pipeline" said MESA Program Director Natasha Forbes-Celise.
